



eSIGN+

eSign+ is a browser-based physician electronic authentication system with intuitive screens for today’s busy providers. Physicians and other providers access, edit and sign transcripts from any Windows PC with an Internet connection. With the addition of Arrendale’s Mobile+ users view and sign on their smart phones and tablets, both Apple and Android. While viewing a transcript on their PC or tablet, physicians may listen to the corresponding dictation voice file by clicking the media player button without having to make a telephone call into the dictation system. eSign+ has been designed for superior speed when editing and signing to accommodate the priorities of physicians. Since no software is loaded on a physician desktop, deployment is quick and easy. eSign+ meets all regulatory requirements for JCAHO, CMS (HCFA), and HIPAA.

PROVIDER FEATURES:

- ◆ Single key electronic approval of each transcript by provider
- ◆ Automatic sequencing to next transcript for signature
- ◆ Quantity of remaining jobs is displayed and updated as provider signs each job
- ◆ Ability to edit a document and save before signing if further review is needed
- ◆ Ability to discard a report and re-dictate if provider desires to start over
- ◆ Ability to return a job to QA team with instructions added for needed corrections
- ◆ Optional feature requires providers to correct blanks (exceptions) due to transcriptionist uncertainty
- ◆ Integrated medical and pharmaceutical spellchecker improves accuracy
- ◆ Ability for providers to sort jobs by status:
 - ◆ All, Inpatient, Outpatient, Saved, Unknown Words or Preceptor
- ◆ Provider review of documents may be configured three ways:
My Patients Only All Patients Within Group Patients Of 1 or More Selected Providers Within Group
- ◆ Provider search and access to previously signed documents within TA+

ADMINISTRATIVE, SECURITY AND PRINTING FEATURES:

- ◆ Management reporting includes reports detailing turnaround times and provider signing activity
- ◆ All addenda are automatically linked to original transcript
 - ◆ “Addendum Exist” is labeled in color at the top of the original transcript to notify users
- ◆ An additional PIN is required to access documents prior to signature
- ◆ Electronic Signature option is only presented to TA+ users with user profile permission to sign
- ◆ Secure Socket Layer (SSL) encryption protects all Internet transmissions
- ◆ eSign+ stores all transcribed versions including original, edits by QA staff and edits by providers
 - ◆ ‘View Versions’ button displays prior versions to supervisors with drill down for detail
- ◆ Typical signature statement reads as below:

“This document has been reviewed and electronically signed by Dr. John Doe on May 4, 2015, at 2:40 P.M.”

- ◆ eSign+ statement may be customized:
 - ◆ To display the signing provider’s name when the signing provider is not the dictating provider
 - ◆ To display provider names and titles per hospital standardization
- ◆ Preliminary copy option, if used, prints “Preliminary” at the top of transcript
- ◆ eSign+ allows or disallows preliminary transcripts to print prior to signature, configured by report type

DUAL SIGNATURE FEATURES:

- ◆ Either resident or preceptor system users may dictate
- ◆ Transcripts dictated by residents require two signatures
- ◆ Physician cross referencing is included for preceptors that may have multiple residents
- ◆ eSign+ includes flexible assigning of preceptors by report type

CLINICAL INFORMATION:

Digital screening mammography of both breasts was performed in the standard projections with bilateral views obtained. Comparison is made to a prior digital mammogram exam performed here on July 8, 2008. The breasts are comprised of a lateral J venous lead dense fibroglandular tissue. Although this pattern is stable, and limits, mammography sensitivity. No suspicious mass, suspicious microcalcifications, or architectural distortion is identified within either breast to suggest the presence of malignancy.

After review and edits, physician options include Sign now, Save for later, Discard completely, Send to QA with note

After each report is signed, E-sign+ updates the quantity of reports remaining in that group
